

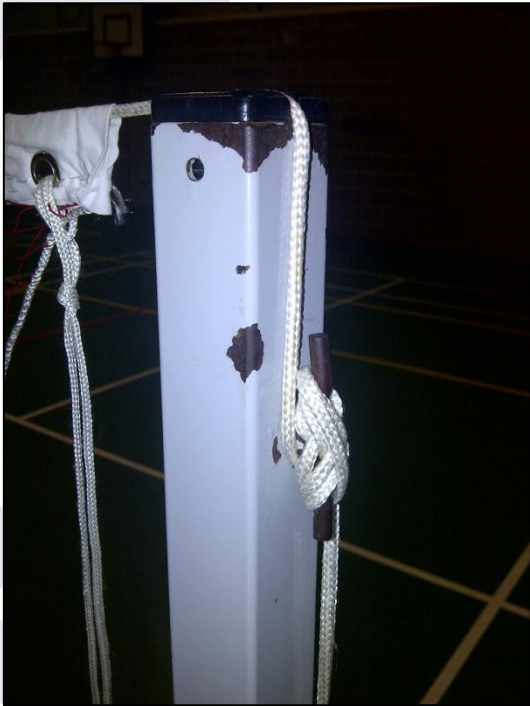


**THIS SHORT PRESENTATION EXPLAINS HOW
TO SETUP INDOOR BADMINTON NETS**

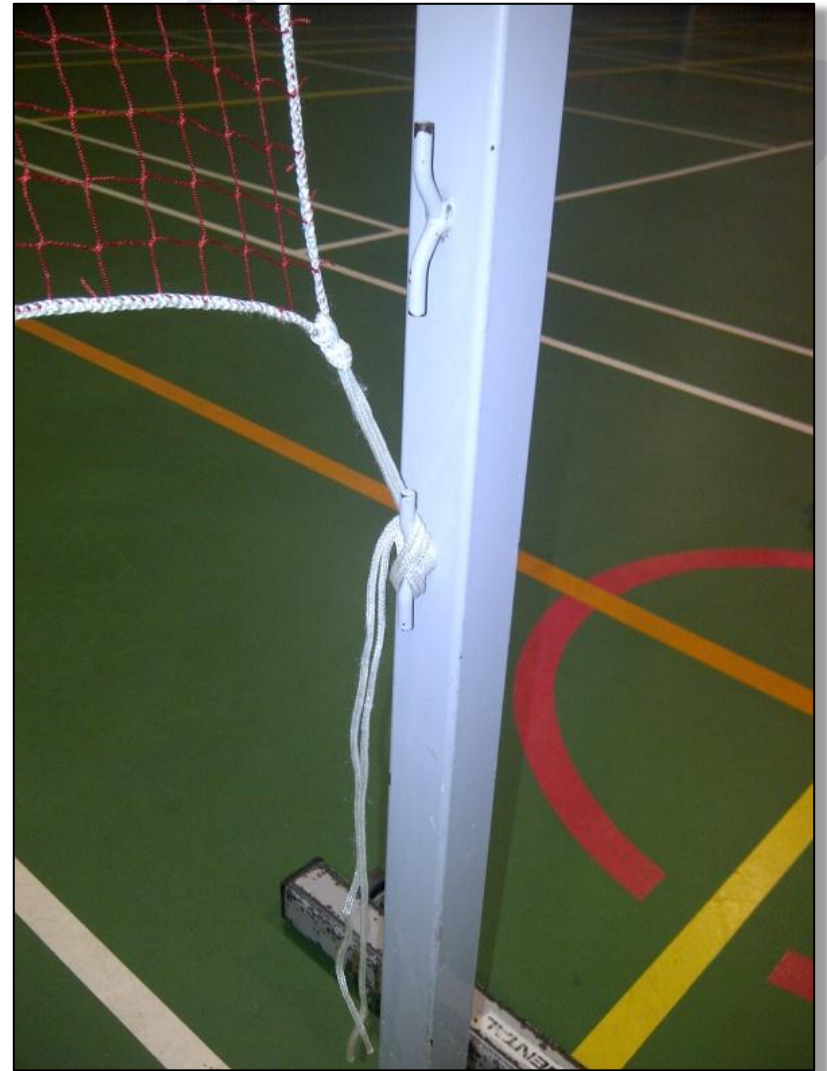
1 – Lay your poles on either side of the court and place them on the outer side lines, with the foot weight outside.




2 – Unwrap the net and tie the thick rope (i.e. the one sliding through the net's white liner) around the first hook on the outside of the pole, making sure that the rope rests on top of the pole. Do the same for the other pole pulling the rope fairly tight.



3 – Tie the lower net string around the inner bottom hook of the pole. Do not pull too tight otherwise it will pull the net down and force it to sag. Do the same for the other side.





4 – Pull the string attached to the net's liner, wrap it around the pole and tie it with a simple knot.





5 – Pull the poles making sure the net is tight and that the white liner is horizontally straight. The net’s height should be 5ft in the middle and you are ready to play!
